

# FACT SHEET ON MIZORAM

The five-year term of 16th Lok Sabha expired on 3.6.2019. The Election Commission of India announced the Schedule for the General Elections to Lok Sabha 2019 for Mizoram and Bye Election of Aizawl West – I (ST) Assembly Constituency on 18th March, 2019. Polling was held on 11th April, 2019 across the State and counting of votes was done on 23rd May, 2019.

The Election was conducted in 1175 Polling Stations and 15 Special Polling Stations for Bru refugees at Kanhmun. 16 Polling Stations had been identified as Critical during this election. Necessary arrangements were made for security and confidence building of voters and other stakeholders in all Polling Stations.

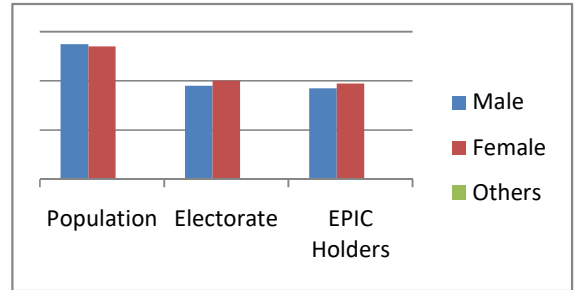

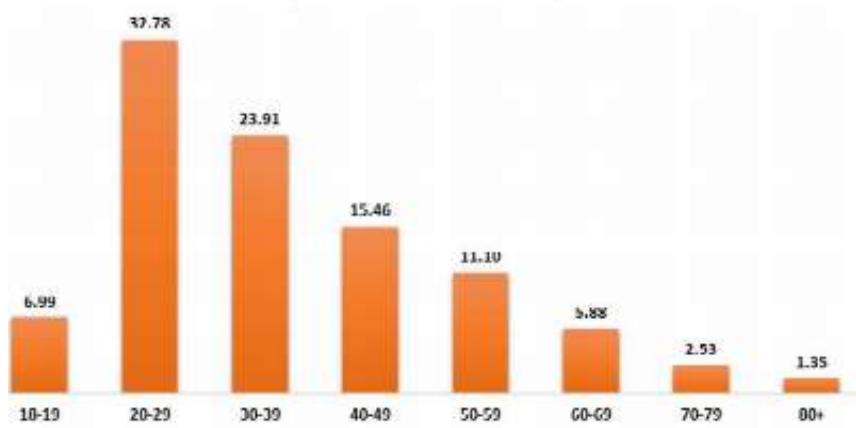

### Age Cohort-wise Percentage of Electors

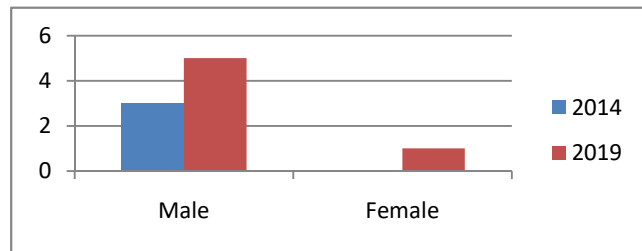

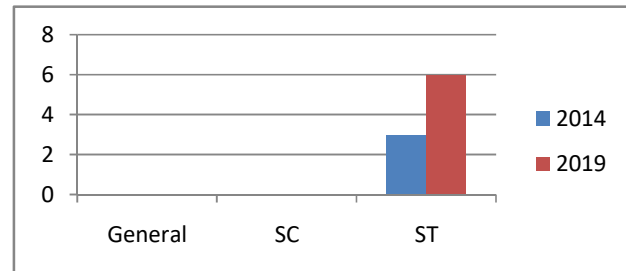

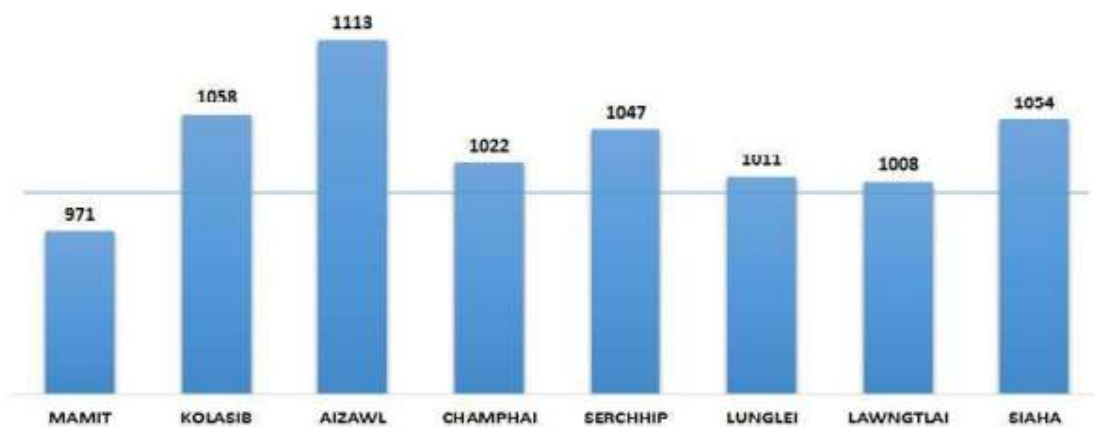

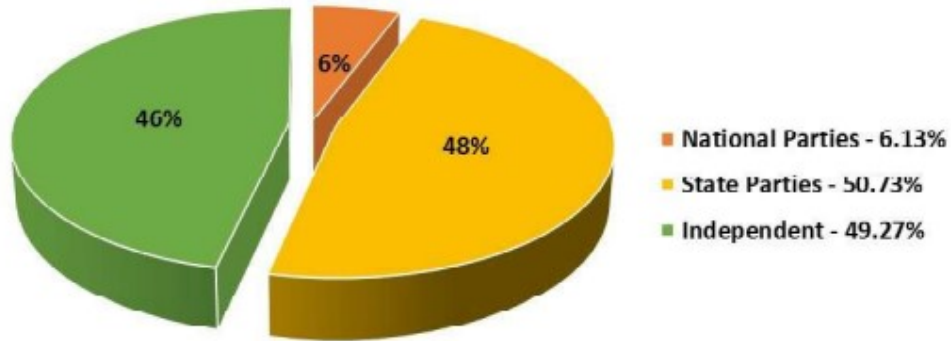

District-wise comparison of Electoral Roll for the year 2014 and 2019

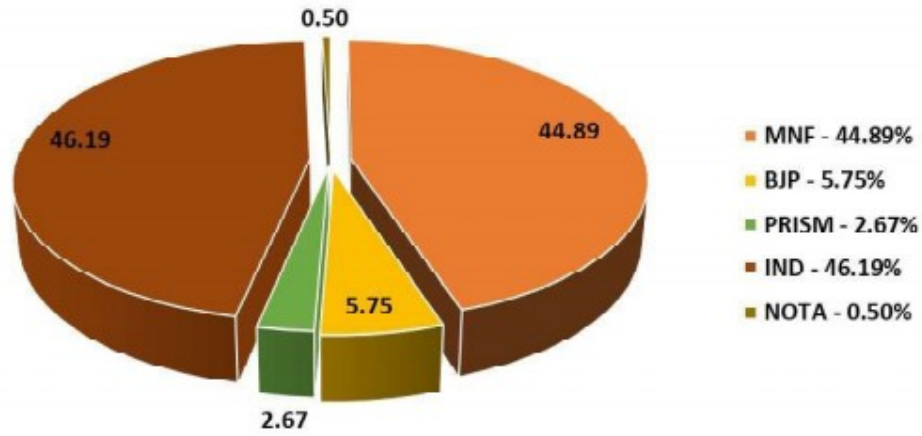
