## National Voters' Day Celebration in Mizoram Date 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2018

National Voters' day was celebrated in Mizoram with lot of enthusiasm and energy. In all the eight districts of the state the celebration was made under the leadership of the Dy. Commissioners in which officials, staffs and members of NGOs participated. At Aizawl, there was state level function. In the morning at 7:00 AM a run to mark NVD was organized in the cold winter of Aizawl. Around 200-250 school boys and girls participated in the run with colourful caps carrying the Flags specially designed for the purpose. The run was joined by the Election officials and staffs including Chief Electoral Officer and others. Voters' pledge was administered to all the participants.
