PRESS NOTE

1. In accordance with the instructions of the Election Commission of India vide No. 23/2025-ERS (Vol. II) dated 14th May, 2026, the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of Electoral Rolls, 2026 was undertaken in all districts of Mizoram with effect from 20th May, 2026. Mizoram is one of the 16 States and 2 Union Territories included in the Third Phase of the Special Intensive Revision, 2026.
2. Before SIR, there was a total of **8,75,068** electors against whom Enumeration Forms were distributed. Out of this, a total of **8,28,906** Enumeration Forms were collected and **46,162** Enumeration Forms were not received.
3. After completion of the Enumeration phase under SIR, the draft roll was published on 4th July, 2026 with a total number of **8,28,906** electors. Electoral Registration Officers and Asst Electoral Registration Officers received and disposed claims and objections (Forms 6, 7 and 8) from 4th July to 2nd September, 2026. The Enumeration Forms received during the Enumeration Phase were also scrutinize during this period. Subsequently against the Draft Roll of 8,28,906 electors, a total of **39,243** electors (4.73%) were added and **32,280** electors (3.89%) were deleted resulting in a net increase of **6,963** electors (0.84%) in the Final Roll.
4. The publication of the Final Electoral Roll was originally scheduled by the Election Commission of India for 6th September, 2026. However, as the scheduled date fell on a Sunday, the publication was rescheduled to 7th September, 2026 (Monday) at the request of the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer, Mizoram.
5. Accordingly, the Final Roll published today, i.e., 7th September has a total of 8,35,869 voters out of which 4,03,179 are male voters, 4,32,689 female voters and 1 Third Gender voter.

There are 4,010 male and 93 female Service Voters, with a total of **4,103 Service Voters** in Mizoram.

6. Further, as per the final electoral roll, the following information are worth mentioning:

Elector Count

- Assembly Constituency with the highest number of elector is 36-Tuichawng (ST) of Lawngtlai District with **37,236** electors while 35-West Tuipui (ST) of Lunglei District has the lowest electors of **14,667**.

Change in Number of Elector

- 10-Aizawl North-I(ST) has the highest number of electors increase from 25,472 electors in Draft Roll to 26,866 electors in the Final Roll with **1,394** total addition of eligible electors i.e., 5.47 % of its Draft Roll.
- 35-West Tuipui (ST) has the highest decrease in elector from 16,477 electors in Draft Roll to 14,677 in the Final Roll with total deletion of **1,800** ineligible electors i.e., 10.9 % of its Draft Roll.

Sex Ratio

- 12-Aizawl North-III(ST) has the highest sex ratio with 1,221 female for every 1,000 males while 35- West Tuipui of Lunglei District has the lowest sex ratio with 848 women for every 1,000 males.

7. An appeal against the decision of the Electoral Registration Officer can be preferred before the District Magistrate **within 15 days from the date of publication of Final Electoral Roll** under section 24(a) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 read with Rule 27 of the Registration of the Electors Rules, 1960.

If dissatisfied with the first appeal decision, a second appeal may be preferred before the Chief Electoral Officer **within 30 days** of the District Magistrate's order as per section 24(b) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 read with Rule 27 of the Registration of the Electors Rules, 1960.

8. Electors are requested to verify their names in the Electoral Roll and, if required, submit applications for inclusion (Form-6), correction (Form-8), or deletion (Form-7) through online or offline modes.
